**A medium ripening time June bearer.
In the Sonata harvesting area.**

Features:

- Very tasteful
- High gloss
- Good firmness & fruit size
- Suitable for direct marketing and short trade channels

Jenkka is a compact growing plant with some overhanging leaves. The flower trusses are relatively short and narrow branched, nevertheless the variety is well pickable and the flowers well protected against night frosts.

Ripening time

- The ripening time is about three-four days after Sonata
- Alternative to Sonata/Sonsation/Polka

Production

- Very high yield
- High share class 1 fruits

Fruit quality

- Conical fruits
- Primary fruit may be slightly grooved, the following fruits are well shaped.
- Jenkka is a very tasty and juicy variety with a high brix, an intense red and shiny colour.
- Darkens slightly further after picking
- Very beautiful fruits
